Worship

NURSERY is provided for children up to 5 years of age during Sunday worship services and special church events. All caregivers are screened and complete child abuse prevention training prior to employment. The Nursery can be found in the front hallway off Surface Hall. Please ask a Host or Usher if you need assistance.

CHILDREN'S CHURCH occurs during the 10:00 AM worship service and is for children age 3 years old through 3rd grade. The children follow the cross out during the singing of the *Gloria* and return during the welcome and announcements.

THE CHILDREN'S WORSHIP PACKETS contain activity sheets and crayons/colored pencils for children to use during worship. They are located beside the stairs to the sacristy in Surface Hall just outside the nave. Please return them after the service.

THE CHILDREN'S QUIET BOOKS are handmade, felt and laminated books for use by children during worship services and can be found on a rack in Surface Hall. Parents and kids are encouraged to use these books during services. We ask that they be used gently and returned at the end of each service.

ASSISTED LISTENING DEVICES are available and located at the back of the church in a basket on a table near the front door. These devices are free for use by parishioners, or guests, who range

from being slightly to profoundly hard of hearing. The receivers pick up the wireless FM broadcast of all the lay and clergy speakers using microphones and reduce room echoes and other distracting sounds. Those not using hearing aids can listen to the receiver with the attached ear buds. Listeners who have hearing aids with a telecoil (telephone coil T-switch) setting option can use the receiver with a neck loop telecoil coupler. The loudness of sound can be adjusted with the volume control wheel located at the top of the receiver. Please stop by the bulletin board in Surface Hall and check-out the information under the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Ministry sign. Questions pertaining to the devices and CEC's Deaf and Hard of Hearing Ministry can be directed to Terry and/or Miliska Knauft.

The system will capture rainwater from the roof and using solar power, pass the water through a series of filters and UV light that will purify the water. The team will also educate the people using spiritual modules as well as basic health and hygiene lessons. Room in the Inn

Christ Church will begin its 4th year of involvement with Room in the Inn. RITI is a program that houses the homeless, or guests, as we like to call them, thru the winter months. The season will run November 15th-March 15th.

We will be hosting twice a month on Wednesday nights. We provide them dinner, breakfast and a sack lunch. Most guests use our laundry and shower facilities and usually enjoy a movie in the EYC lounge. Ways to be involved include making meals, making up the cots with linens, taking and picking up the linens from the laundry, but most importantly, being an innkeeper. Innkeepers must be available from 5:00 PM-7:00 AM the following morning. They insure everything is ready for our guests.
