### Worship

**NURSERY** is provided for children up to 5 years of age during Sunday worship services and special church events. All caregivers are screened and complete child abuse prevention training prior to employment. The Nursery can be found in the front hallway off Surface Hall. Please ask a Host or Usher if you need assistance.

**CHILDREN'S CHURCH** occurs during the 10:00 AM worship service and is for children age 3 years old through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. The children follow the cross out during the singing of the *Gloria* and return during the welcome and announcements.

**THE CHILDREN'S WORSHIP PACKETS** contain activity sheets and crayons/colored pencils for children to use during worship. They are located beside the stairs to the sacristy in Surface Hall just outside the nave. Please return them after the service.

**THE CHILDREN'S QUIET BOOKS** are handmade, felt and laminated books for use by children during worship services and can be found on a rack in Surface Hall. Parents and kids are encouraged to use these books during services. We ask that they be used gently and returned at the end of each service.

ASSISTED LISTENING DEVICES are available and located at the back of the church in a basket on a table near the front door. These devices are free for use by parishioners, or guests, who range from being slightly to profoundly hard of hearing. The receivers pick up the wireless FM broadcast of all the lay and clergy speakers using microphones and reduce room echoes and other distracting sounds. Those not using hearing aids can listen to the receiver with the attached ear buds. Listeners who have hearing aids with a telecoil (telephone coil T-switch) setting option can use the receiver with a neck loop telecoil coupler. The loudness of sound can be adjusted with the volume control wheel located at the top of the receiver. Please stop by the bulletin board in Surface Hall and check-out the

information under the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Ministry sign. Questions pertaining to the devices and CEC's Deaf and Hard of Hearing Ministry can be directed to Terry and/or Miliska Knauft.

SACRED CONVERSATIONS-CLOISTER COMMUNITY UPDATE - As many of you are aware, in October of last year, Christ Church began to see a significant increase in the number of people experiencing homelessness staying on our porches. After several weeks of growing pains, several volunteers joined with your clergy team to create the Sacred Conversations group to pray for and with our Cloister Community in search of a way forward for them and for us. From the beginning, our goal has been to provide a safe, temporary place for people experiencing homelessness to spend the night. Just before Christmas, we published a set of community expectations, which have been worked out with our guests, and have created a much cleaner and safer environment for everyone. Three times a day, members of the Sacred Conversations group are on campus ensuring that the expectations are being followed. A change in Sunday morning habits has added maybe a dozen new breakfast folks, but in conversation with our breakfast teams, it seems that we can continue to provide a place of fellowship for members of our 8 am, 10 am, and cloister communities. Much of

this work has been reactive, as this is a fluid population. Much of it has been slow moving, as relationships take time to develop. But in faith, with prayer, and in concert with city, county, and non-profit leadership, we continue to be hopeful that our goals can be met and that our cloister guests can find long-term housing solutions. If you would like to know more, the Sacred Conversations group meets every Wednesday at 4pm in the Conference Room, or join us for Prayer on the Porch, Mondays, beginning this week, at 4pm in the Cloister.

### **ECM & EYC Mission Trips**

The Episcopal Campus Ministry will take a Spring Pilgrimage to the Peace and Justice Memorial in Montgomery, Alabama the first weekend of March. While there we will spend time steeped in prayer and in reflection of the ways in which race and racism play into our society, especially as we visit the site of the lynching memorial. Additionally, Mother Becca will offer readings from James Cone's The Cross and the Lynching Tree and the students will have time to reflect individually and communally about how we might better live into our baptismal covenant in light of what we observe.

The Episcopal Youth Community has two mission trips planned. In July, High School aged youth will be joining youth of Province IV in North Carolina to help with continued hurricane relief projects. Additionally, we are working with St. John's Church in Murray, KY on a mission trip in the fall for all ages.
