Worship

NURSERY is provided for children up to 5 years of age during Sunday worship services and special church events. All caregivers are screened and complete child abuse prevention training prior to employment. The Nursery can be found in the front hallway off Surface Hall. Please ask a Host or Usher if you need assistance.

CHILDREN’S CHURCH occurs during the 10:00 AM worship service and is for children age 3 years old through 3rd grade. The children follow the cross out during the singing of the *Gloria* and return during the welcome and announcements.

THE CHILDREN’S WORSHIP PACKETS contain activity sheets and crayons/colored pencils for children to use during worship. They are located beside the stairs to the sacristy in Surface Hall just outside the nave. Please return them after the service.

THE CHILDREN’S QUIET BOOKS are handmade, felt and laminated books for use by children during worship services and can be found on a rack in Surface Hall. Parents and kids are encouraged to use these books during services. We ask that they be used gently and returned at the end of each service.

ASSISTED LISTENING DEVICES are available and located at the back of the church in a basket on a table near the front door. These devices are free for use by parishioners, or guests, who range from being slightly to profoundly hard of hearing. The receivers pick up the wireless FM broadcast of all the lay and clergy speakers using microphones and reduce room echoes and other distracting sounds. Those not using hearing aids can listen to the receiver with the attached ear buds. Listeners who have hearing aids with a telecoil (telephone coil T-switch) setting option can use the receiver with a neck

loop telecoil coupler. The loudness of sound can be adjusted with the volume control wheel located at the top of the receiver. Please stop by the bulletin board in Surface Hall and check-out the information under the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Ministry sign. SACRED CONVERSATIONS-CLOISTER COMMUNITY UPDATE - Things in the cloister do not always go as planned. Monday afternoon was no exception. Prayer on the Porch began a little after 4:00. A small group of us including one individual from the Cloister Community gathered. Two more joined as Mother Becca began explaining the “order” of things - she would pray over the space and for those in the community, then five minutes of carefully timed silence followed by an invitation for prayers from anyone for anyone. Father Steve would close us out with prayer.

During our silent time the Holy Spirit guided Mr. L to us and he could not be silent. He fell to his knees praying softly till he could hold it in no longer. Mr. L stood and began praying aloud, pouring out words of praise to God, thanksgiving, and petitions to watch over those who stay here. He

shared a piece of his personal death and resurrection story (addiction and the early stages of recovery). Mr. E joined in praying for guidance for those leading our country and talked of agape love. Ms. M shared her plans for moving getting a roof over her head and a pillow under it. Father Steve closed us in prayer and we scattered. It did not go exactly as planned, thanks be to God.

ECM & EYC Mission Trips

The Episcopal Campus Ministry will take a Spring Pilgrimage to the Peace and Justice Memorial in Montgomery, Alabama the first weekend of March. While there we will spend time steeped in prayer and in reflection of the ways in which race and racism play into our society, especially as we visit the site of the lynching memorial. Additionally, Mother Becca will offer readings from James Cone's *The Cross and the Lynching Tree* and the students will have time to reflect individually and communally about how we might better live into our baptismal covenant in light of what we observe.

The Episcopal Youth Community has two mission trips planned. In July, High School aged youth will be joining youth of Province IV in North Carolina to help with continued hurricane relief projects. Additionally, we are working with St. John's Church in Murray, KY on a mission trip in the fall for all ages.
