

Phase One: Church at Home

This is our current phase, and will continue until the implementation of Phase Two in mid-to-late July.

Phase Two: Church at Home and A Good Place to Say Your Prayers

In this phase, the inclusion of prayer time in the Nave accompanies the inclusion of a minimal staff presence in-office, and flows from the Bishop lifting the Pastoral Directive canceling in person worship. The Rector, in consultation with the Wardens, holds the right to return to the guidelines of **Church at Home** at any time.

 - Sunday worship is live-streamed from the Nave at 10 am
 - o Midweek Prayer Time
 - Monday through Thursday from 9:30 am to 3:30 pm, at the bottom of the hour, one person or family unit will be allowed into the Nave for 30 minutes of prayer. Evening hours will also be available, times TBA. Pews will be sanitized after each visit.
 - Hand sanitizer is available throughout the building
 - Social Distancing in effect
 - Temperature checks and health screenings will be administered
 - Masks will be required

- Learn and Grow Together same as Phase One
- Radiate God's Love to All same as Phase One
- Administration
 - Vonda will be in office, and other Staff may choose to work from home or the office, as they see fit. Safety protocols, including temperature checks and masks, will be followed

Phase Three: Church at Home and in the Pews

When the Bishop lifts his Pastoral Directive forbidding in-person gatherings, and we feel comfortable that in the pews worship can be added to **Church at Home** and **A Good Place to Say your Prayers**, the following guidelines will be mandatory for all. The Restart Taskforce will revisit the plans for this phase on a bi-weekly basis, but will not be consider moving to phase three until at least August 4th. The Rector, in consultation with the Wardens, holds the right to cancel in-person worship at any time.
